Diving Deeper into Scripture Memorization

3 words you will see often within this booklet:

Implant

Implant the weekly verse deep within your heart by repeating it numerous times a day.

Embrace

Embrace the verse you've just implanted by continuing to cling to it along with each week's new verse.

Enact

Enact the verses you've implanted by putting them into action in your daily life. Don't just memorize the Word; live it!

May we suggest a help to aid you in getting the most out of this tool? Before you begin, ask the Lord to give you someone who can walk this journey with you. Commit to hold each other accountable to memorizing Psalm 91. Meet weekly to share verses, chat about how you're enacting God's Word into your daily walk, and sign off on each other's weekly Scripture card.

How to use this tool:

*Print out each card. Glue on spiral bound 3 x 5 index cards or in 3.5 x 5.5 moleskine ruled journals. (We've purchased both products at Wal-mart and Target)

*Check off daily boxes as you complete implanting and embracing for the day. May we suggest that you review the verses you're implanting at least 7 times each day; 7 being a number of completion throughout the Scriptures.
